# If you like history...pay a visit to Nunoichi Shrine


Nunoichi Shrine is associated with the Togashi Clan that once ruled the Kaga Province, and well-known for the Kabuki play "Kanjincho". A stone monument called "Benkei's power stone", supposedly thrown all the way from Togashi Clan's mansion, remains in the precincts of the shrine. Fugakudo's "Monaka Kanjincho" shaped after Benkei's scroll is also popular as a lucky charm for overcoming difficulties.



# 2 Nunoichi Shrine

Dedicated to "Sumiyoshi Sanjin" (the three Shinto deities of the sea), this shrine is believed to be established by the Togashi Clan of the Kaga Province.

Have a look at the monument inscribed with a poem composed by Shogoin Doko when he stopped by Nonoichi, and the statue of the guardian dog standing on its front leas.

The magnificent ginkgo tree that towers over the precincts of the shrine is estimated to be 500 years old.

# ③ Kita Family House (Designated National Important Cultural Property)

A refined wooden structure that retains the architectural beauty of traditional Japanese house from the Edo period. It was also a sake brewery that produced various kinds of renowned sake such as "Shoiyo" for over 100 years. Enjoy the view of an open tatami room with a beautifully patterned hearth and an elegant garden.
